 - Want to employ a social worker (\$20,000/year) to go into student's houses to help them with their problems
- Every Year Advisor will go through a Mental Health First Aid Course this year help prevent and deal with mental health problems
- Uniform it is all about the image that we give to the community; how the students wear the hoodie can show a lesser image than if they didn't wear one
